Known widely as Chicago's Queen of House Music, Darlene Jackson aka Lady D has been rocking dance floors nationally and internationally since 1995.

She has played such places as Russia, Germany, Mexico, Canada, Thailand and extensively across the USA.

Recognized for her top-notch A&R, production and remixing talents as owner of D'lectable Music, Lady D is respected industry-wide for releasing some of the hottest records in House music over the past three years.

Lady D has represented for Chicago House Music on film (the Godfather of Disco, Girl The Movie, Channel 4-UK), television (Metro TV-NYC, CLTV, WGN, Hot Wax), radio (Q101, Chicago Public Radio, KTUH-Honolulu, Vibe FM-UK) and print--this media darling has been featured in such mags as Billboard, Spin, International DJ, Red Eye/Metromix, The Chicago Tribune, Time Out, UR Chicago, Chicago Scene, Venus, DMA, 5 Mag and most recently the April 2008 issue of Chicago Magazine.

She made her name in the mid 90's for being one of the first women DJ's on the underground house scene in Chicago and grew to become one of the most respected industry players who continues to emerge from the Chicago House 3rd wave following in the steps of Derrick Carter, Diz, Sneak and Gene Farris among others.

DJ Lady D is not limited by any preconceived notion of House—her sets drift seamlessly into territories other's fear to tread. She moves playfully from tracks to vocals, from Boombity to

Electro to jackin' Tech House and back with finesse. Lady D has a unique way of not only making the mix sound good but also making these seemingly distinct genres feel like they actually belong together. That's a gift, a talent; and Lady D is one of a few who can pull that off, (some say like a female Mark Farina!) because her ear for selecting is just that good.

Her abilities include production and remixing and she has collaborated with Ron Carroll, Demarkus Lewis, Common Factor and Mark Grant. Behind the decks for over a decade, DJ Lady D is a true professional, able to control any dance floor in any club she plays—from Bangkok to Waikiki from Moscow to Montreal—D has made many a flat-ironed “do” frizzy by night's end.
